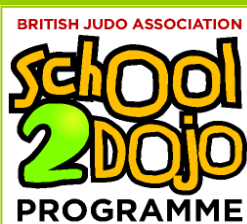




Does your club need cash to develop?

“By linking in with the Partnership Development Manager and the extending activity programme, we have had a greater impact in our local schools. The club hosts regular coaching sessions and inter-school competitions. Since starting we have had 50 new members!” Vale Judo Club.



To increase your number of junior members, ‘Extending Activities’ funding is for you.

Your local County Sport Partnership will have an “open fund” where clubs can apply to run a 10 week course of judo in a local school. However, there are some simple criteria to follow:

- 1) Engage young people aged 5-19 that would not normally take part in standard PE sports.
- 2) keep them participating for a minimum of 6 sessions on the 10 week course over a school term.
- 3) Sustain and grow them into a member of your club. If you have CLUBMARK you can use the School 2 Dojo resources packs.
- 4) As a club decide on your target group and think of some interesting schemes.
