New EJU rules starting 1.1. 2010

2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down the arm - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm only for national colours, and manufacturer's trade mark from official suppliers only. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)



§ judogi

The contestants shall wear a Judogi complying with the following conditions:
Strongly made of cotton or similar material (see guideline), in good condition (without rent or tear). The material must not be so thick or hard or slippery as to prevent the opponent from taking a grip. Blue for the first contestant and white or off-white for the second contestant.

Obligated markings:

Back identification of athletes must include name and country:

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi an appropriate back number consisting of two parts: Fixed upper part with surname and National Olympic Abbreviation.
Changeable lower part reserved for sponsors and or EJU event presentation, unique for each particular event.
2. The unified back numbers, Bibs of athletes are described in annex: EJU Back Number
3. Logistics of acquiring of the EJU Back Number is described in annex: Ordering Procedure of EJU Back Numbers
4. Only the original EJU Back Numbers carrying the EJU Trade Mark and acquired exclusively according to procedure in Article 3 will be accepted at Judogi control.
5. The EJU Back Numbers are obligatory for all European Championships, World Cups in the territory of EJU, European Cups, and eventually other events specified by EJU. It includes all Categories Seniors, U23, U20, U17, Veterans.



Acceptable markings

1. National Emblem (on left breast of jacket). Maximum size 100 cm².
2. Shoulder markings (from collar - across shoulder down the arm - both sides of jacket). Maximum length 25 cm and maximum width 5 cm only for national colours, and manufacturer's trade mark from official suppliers only. (The same advertising or national colours can be on both sides)
3. Manufacturer's trade mark (on bottom-front of jacket, on bottom front of left leg of the trouser and on end of the belt.) Maximum size 20 cm². EJU official Suppliers are allowed to place the "EJU proved" Logo over their trade mark (in direct contact) on bottom front of jacket. It is permitted to place the manufacturer's trade mark on one of the sleeves but inside the 25 cm x 5 cm area instead of at the bottom front of the jacket. (max 20 cm²)
4. Advertising on the sleeves, 10 cm x 10 cm on each sleeve (different advertising allowed). These 100 cm² have to be fixed just below and in contact with the Shoulder markings of 25 cm x 5 cm.
5. Indication of the placing (1st, 2nd, 3rd) at the Olympic Games or World Championships, in an area of 6 cm x 10 cm at the bottom front left side of the jacket.
6. The contestant's name may be worn (printed or embroidered) on the belt, lower front of the jacket and upper front of the trousers up to a maximum of 3 cm x 10 cm.
