Section D Competitors born 1992 - 1993 – 1994 inclusive. **SHIMEWAZA & KANSETZU-WAZA ALLOWED**
JUNIOR (MINIMUM GRADE 13th Mon or 2nd Kyu)
MALE: u55kg, u60kg, u66kg, u73kg, u81kg, u90kg, u100kg, o100kg

All competitors MUST hold a valid B.J.A B.J.C A.J.A Licence and be able to produce it on the day when booking in.

All competitors MUST be a bona fide member of a Club Registered as a member of the North West Area
