

## BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIP EASTERN AREA TRIALS

The Eastern Area will be holding Trials for the British Championships being held at iceSheffield, Coleridge Road, Sheffield S9 5DA on the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> October 2010 with the following criteria, as laid down by the BJA.

Pre Cadet Girls (born 1997/98) Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2010

-32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg & +63kg

Pre Cadet Boys (born 1997/98) Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2009

-30kg, -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg & +66kg

Minimum grade 10<sup>th</sup> Mon – Shimewaza and Kansetsu-waza are not permitted in any weight category.

Contest duration 3 minutes, golden score 2 minutes.

Cadet Girls (born 1995/96) Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2010

-40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, 57kg, 63kg, -70kg & +70kg

Cadet Boys (born 1995/96) Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2010

-38kg, -42kg, 46kg, 50kg, 55kg, 60kg, 66kg, 73kg, 81kg, 90kg & +90kg.

Minimum grade 10<sup>th</sup> Mon or 3<sup>rd</sup> Kyu – Shimewaza are permitted and Kansetsu-waza are not permitted in any weight category.

Contest duration 3 minutes, golden score 2 minutes

Junior Women (born 1992/93/94) Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2010

-44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg & +78kg.

Junior Men (born 1992/93/94) Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2010

-55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg & +100kg.

Minimum grade 13<sup>th</sup> Mon or 2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu – Shimewaza and Kansetsu-waza are permitted in all weight categories.

Contest duration 4 minutes, golden score 2 minutes.

## General Information

This will be a pool on pool competition. The final 4 players will qualify to represent the Area at the British Championships. It will be the responsibility of parents to bare all costs which will include an overnight stay in Sheffield. Entry can be by paper or on line a copy of the entry form will be given to the medallists on the day which will give details on how to enter players.

If a player misses the Trials through injury or illness (doctor's note required) and a place is available they will be allowed to enter following approval from the Area and the BJA Performance Directorate via the Wild Card Process
