Notice from the BJA Performance Directorate:

The primary goal of the British Judo Association's (BJA) World Class Performance Programme is to deliver medals at the 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games. It is on the basis that we deliver Olympic and Paralympic medals that we receive funding from UK Sport.

As you already know, we are in the process of fully evaluating all squad players in terms of their technical and tactical competencies, together with their future potential. From 1st April ALL Athlete Personal Awards will be awarded following the **Application and Evaluation** process and the commitment to train within the British Judo Performance Network. **(Deadline extended to MONDAY 15th DECEMBER 2008 for Senior Players - Junior players will receive information in January 2009)**

We therefore are employing an interim measure in terms of Athlete Personal Awards until Full Player Evaluations are completed. Therefore at this stage only 3 month interim awards have been made to the following players based purely on recent results; **Podium** - 2008 Olympic Games Top 8, 2007 Worlds Medal, **Development** - 2008 U23 and U20 World and European Top 5, 2008 Super World Cup and World Cup medals (minimum 2), 2007 U23 and U20 European Medals - All awards from 1 April 2009 will be decided once the Evaluation process has finished.
