Subject: **National Dan Grade Register - Update for Great Britain Representation**

Players, Coaches, Support Staff:

Whenever a player is selected to represent Great Britain at a World Cup level event or higher (A-Tournament or higher for Junior), each win will be translated to 10 points towards their Dan Grade.

The excerpt below is taken from the current version of the National Dan Grade Syllabus:

Opportunities for Scoring Points Towards Promotion at Competitions:

Olympic Games
Senior and Junior World Individual Championships
Senior and Junior European Individual Championships
Super World Cups
World Cups
Senior International B Tournaments

Any player representing the BJA at the above official EJU/IJF competitions will be awarded 10 points towards their next grade for every contest won regardless of the score except for Kiken-gachi and Fusen-gachi.

Candidates must complete the relevant time in grade, theory and age requirements for each grade, up to and including 5th Dan.

TO CLARIFY, PLAYERS MUST BE SELECTED BY THE BJA IN ORDER TO GAIN POINTS.

I believe this has been tried in the past, but Dave Horton-Jones has given it another push, and therefore it is re-launched from the 2008 Junior World Championships.
