



Job Description Judo Coach

UKCC level 1 & 2 coaches to enhance the workforce of the PL4S programme.

Coaches will be part of the Everton & Liverpool football clubs coaching team, delivering sessions and activities in the satellite clubs, and taster sessions in schools during the curriculum, across Liverpool & Knowsley. Some work on holiday programmes will also be available

Applicants will have experience of working with groups of young people with varying abilities and skills, ages ranging from 8- 16, and in a range of facilities. Applicants must have the flexibility to adapt their coaching accordingly. A clear understanding of organising a structured and progressive programme of coaching, and developing a competitive element is essential to these roles. There will also be a requirement to mentor leaders and volunteers who assist in the clubs. Some travelling between venues may be required.

The football clubs will build a programme of work around successful applicant's availability.

Employment will be on a casual basis, and rates of pay will be dependant on qualifications and experience. Further training opportunities may be available.
