Entry Process	<p>There are two methods of entry for this year's event. The original paper entry process and a new online entry system. The online entry system will be a more secure process and will allow for confirmation to be obtained within moments of your entry being processed.</p> <p>The online system will ensure that your entry is processed correctly and that your payment is taken via a secure site. As you MUST provide a copy of your British Passport or British Birth Certificate there is an upload section for you to provide you eligibility online, otherwise it can be sent via fax to 0871 266 4749.</p> <p>We would recommend that you complete the application online to ensure all of your details are correct.</p> <p>By using the online booking system it will eliminate the chance of your entry getting lost in the post, processing errors of your details and allow a secure payment to be made.</p> <p>The web address for the online entry system is www.britishjudo.org.uk/enteronline</p> <p>Unfortunately we cannot accept card payments from American Express and Visa Electron cards.</p> <p>Closing date for entries is strictly Monday 14th December 2009.</p>
Participation:	<p>Minimum grades: Blue Belt (2nd Kyu or 15th Mon)</p> <p>All players must be born in one of the following years: 1991; 1992; 1993; 1994, 1995</p> <p>All players must have British nationality and must bring their valid BJA/BJC/AJA judo licence to the event and MUST send a copy of their British passport or British Birth Certificate to the BJA along with their entry form.</p> <p>The wearing of blue / white judogi is COMPULSORY for this event.</p>
Competition Format:	<p>The method of elimination for this event will be pools to pools. The first two players in each pool will qualify for the next round of pools.</p> <p>Please note: Depending on the number of entries a different competition format may be used.</p> <p>Contest times will be 4 minutes . 2 minutes Golden Score.</p> <p>The final pool of 4 players from each weight category will go forward to create the 2009 British Junior Squad. Medals will be presented after all final pool fights have been completed. British Junior Squad members will receive an Induction Pack at the medal ceremony.</p> <p>This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.</p>

Seeding:	Seeding will be carried out by Performance Staff in consideration of the 2009 Junior Trials and 2009 Junior International Results'
Weight Categories:	<p>Young Men: U55kg, U60kg, U66kg, U73kg, U81kg, U90kg, U100kg, O100kg</p> <p>Young Women: U44kg, U48kg, U52kg, U57kg, U63kg, U70kg, U78kg, O78kg</p> <p>Please note: Test scales will be available at registration (where the organisers must be notified of any weight category changes). No changes of weight category will be permitted after the player has weighed in on the official scales. Players who do not make their weight category will be automatically eliminated from the competition and entry fees will not be refunded.</p>

As a high number of the competitors are going to be under 18 an open weigh in will take place at this event, therefore all players entering this event regardless of age will be weighed in under U18 rules. Please note that due to this ALL competitors will receive the weight allowance and therefore ALL competitors MUST weigh in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers for boys (0.5kg) or competition acceptable judogi trousers and t-shirt for girls (0.6kg). Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.</p>



<p>Directions:</p>	<p>Directions to EIS Sheffield:</p> <p>From M1 (travelling North): Leave motorway at junction 34 (Sheffield Meadowhall). At the roundabout follow signs A6178 City Centre and Attercliffe. Go past Meadowhall Shopping Centre on your right. Keep straight on this road. Go past the Sheffield Arena on your left. Keep straight on this road (Attercliffe Road). EIS Sheffield is on Coleridge road by the traffic lights (by Natwest Bank)</p> <p>M1 (travelling South): Leave motorway at Junction 34. Follow brown signs for Don Valley Stadium / HallamFM Arena (A6109 also signed City). Pass Meadowhall shopping centre on your left, travelling straight on for approximately two miles. At the first roundabout turn left on to Hawke Street / Janson Street (following signs for Don Valley Stadium / Hallam FM Arena). At next roundabout turn right on to Attercliffe Common (A6178), signed iceSheffield. At second set of traffic lights (opposite Natwest bank) turn left onto Coleridge Road. Take next right into car park.</p> <p>From City Centre: Follow signs for M1 / M18 until reaching Park Square Roundabout. From roundabout use lane signed A57. See brown signs for Lower Don Valley (A6109). After exiting roundabout on to A57 "Sheffield Parkway" take left lane at first set of traffic lights signed "Lower Don Valley (A6109)". At second set of lights turn right onto Wicker. At stone arches bare right on to Savile Street A6109. Carry straight on for 2 miles following signs for "Don Valley Stadium / Hallam FM Arena". At first roundabout turn right signed (Hallam FM Arena / Don Valley Stadium) on to A6102 Hawke Street / Janson Street. At next roundabout turn right on to Attercliffe Road A6178. Take second left (opposite Natwest bank) onto Coleridge Road. Take first right into EIS Sheffield.</p> <p>Supertram: Catch the yellow route tram from Sheffield City Centre or Meadowhall Shopping Centre. Get off the tram at the Don Valley Stadium / Arena tram stop. EIS Sheffield is just two minutes walk from the tram stop.</p>
