**ELIGIBILITY:**

Competitors will be required to produce a current BJA or affiliated licence with photograph and provide proof of age/eligibility by Birth Certificate OR Passport.

Licence MUST show Area of representation as Yorkshire & Humberside, and the player must also have been a member of their said Area for a minimum of 90 days from 5/07/2010.

Competitors with an out of date or No Licence will NOT be allowed to compete  
All competitors should provide their own Blue & White belts

**BOOK IN/WEIGH IN:**

Pre Cadet 9.00 - 9.30 a.m. ALL WEIGHTS

Cadet 11.00 – 11.30 am ALL WEIGHTS

Junior 11.30 am – 12.00 ALL WEIGHTS

ALL Male Competitors MUST be weighed in with their Judogi trousers on  
(An allowance of 0.5kg should be made for this.)

ALL female Competitors MUST be weighed in with their Judogi trousers and a white 'T' shirt on (An allowance of 0.6kg should be made for this.)

**AGE/WEIGHT CATEGORIES:**

**Pre Cadet (Competitors born 1997-1998) Minimum Grade Green Belt**

Boys: U30, U34, U38, U42, U46, U50, U55, U60, U66, Over 66kg

Girls: U32, U36, U40, U44, U48, U52, U57, Over 57kg

**Cadet (Competitors born 1995-1996) Minimum Grade Green Belt**

Boys: U38, U42, U46, U50, U55, U60, U66, U73, U81, U90, Over 90kg.

Girls: U40, U44, U48, U52, U57, U63, U70, Over 70kg

Strangles are permitted but armlocks are NOT permitted in the Cadet event

**Junior (Competitors born 1992, 1993, 1994) Minimum Grade Blue Belt**

Boys:- U55, U60, U66, U73, U 81, U90, U100, Over 100kg

Girls:- U44, U48, U52, U57, U63, U70, U78, Over 78kg

Both Strangles & Armlocks ARE permitted in the Junior event

Selections for the British Championships will be based on the top 4 in each weight category.

Entry forms for the British Championships will be available to the top 4 in each weight category for completion/payment on the day.  
Please can all competitors ensure they bring a payment method and a photocopy of their eligibility proof (birth certificate OR British Passport) to the Y&H Trials event in order that a British Championships entry form can be completed on the day and handed back to the Area.

The completed entry forms will then be returned to the BJA with the Trials results.

**METHOD OF COMPETITION:**

Pools Throughout

The Golden Score will be in operation throughout the competition - 2 Minute duration.
