And be a BJA registered member of a West Yorkshire Club or University within West Yorkshire OR reside in West Yorkshire. Licence should show Yorkshire & Humberside as Area of representation..**
- PLEASE NOTE:** (Birth Certificate may be required) A Senior licence must be produced for Event 3

- AGES:** Event 1: 8 years and under 12 on the day.
Event 2: 12 years and under 16 on the day.

- BOOK IN/WEIGH IN:** Event 1: 8.30 to 9.30 am Event 2: 11.00 am to 12.00 Event 3 12.00 til 12.30
ALL Male Competitors MUST be weighed in with their Judogi trousers on (An allowance of 0.5kg should be made for this)
ALL Female Competitors MUST be weighed in with their Judogi trousers And a white ‘T’ shirt on (An allowance of 0.6kg should be made for this)
- WEIGHT CATEGORIES:**
- Event 1:** Boys: U30, U34, U38, U42, U46, over 46kg.
Girls: U32, U36, U40, U44, over 44kg.
- Event 2:** Boys: U42, U46, U50, U55, U60, U66, Over 66kg
Girls: Upto 40kg/ Upto 52kg / Over 52kg
- Event 3:** Men: U73kg, U90kg /Over 90kg Beginner to Green Belt 3rd Kyu
Men: U73kg, U90kg, Over 90kg Blue Belt 2nd Kyu and above
Women:Upto 57kg / Upto 70kg /Over 70kg All Senior Grades
- RULES:** Events 1 & 2 **No armlocks or strangles will be allowed**
Event 1 **BJA Technical Restrictions applicable 1st January 2007 apply**
Event 3 **BJA Senior rules will apply**
The Golden Score System will be in operation throughout the competition.
