**Date:** Sunday 13th March 2011  
**Venue:** Crystal Palace National Sport Centre, Ledrington Road,  
London SE19 2BB

**Eligibility:** Competitors must hold current membership of the BJA, Judo Scotland, WJA, NIJF, BJC or AJA.  
This must be produced at the weigh-in/registration. Players from abroad must show membership of an organization recognized by the IJF/EJU

Competitors must be born in the years 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996

**Weight Categories:**

**Women:** u44k; u48k; u52k; u57k u63k; u70k; u78k; over 78kilos

**Men:** u55k; u60k; u66k; u73k; u81k; u90k; u100k; over 100kilos

**Registration/Weigh In:** 07:30am to 08:30am. Women u44k to u57k. Men u55k to u73k.  
10:30am to 11:00am All remaining weight groups.

As there will be under 18 year old competitors an open weigh-in will take place and the normal allowance will be given – 0.5kg for male competitors and 0.6kg for female competitors. Competitors must present themselves to the weigh-in in appropriate judo-gi.

**Method of Elimination:** As this event is being used to create a British Junior Domestic Squad, the method of elimination for the competition will be decided in consultation with the BJA Performance Staff once the entry numbers are known. The organisers reserve the right to combine weight categories if insufficient entries.

**Duration of Contests:** Four (4) minutes; two (2) minutes golden score.

**Judogi:** First player called must wear a blue suit, second player must wear a white suit

**Seeding:** Top four medalists from 2010 event in the same weight category, plus any requested by BJA High Performance Staff for BJA Competitors only.

**Please Note:** Random drug testing may be carried out at this event by UK Anti-Doping. Therefore any player entering the event may be drug tested and will need to obtain a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if taking any medication containing banned substances.
