<i>General Rules</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ BJA contest rules will be operative throughout this event; all other regulations regarding the event will be in accordance with the BJA Tournament Handbook. ➤ Medallists must wear judogi during the medal presentations. Medals will only be presented when each group is completed. ➤ Competitors must wear suitable footwear at all times when off the mat. ➤ Points Scoring – Seniors and Youth where appropriate. ➤ The first player called may wear a blue or white suit but must wear a blue belt. ➤ The ‘Golden Score’ will operate throughout the event. ➤ Any rules incorporated after the issue of this entry form will also apply. ➤ Double knockout will be in use throughout the event, however if a group has seven or less players, a pools system may be used. ➤ If there are insufficient entries in a weight group the organiser reserves the right to combine weight groups after consultation with the appropriate competitors.
<i>Coaching Passes</i>	To ensure that the arena floor is kept as clear as possible, only coaches with a valid coaching card will be allowed entry to the arena floor. To avoid any problems regarding access to the arena floor please ensure you bring your card with you to the event.
<i>Under 12’s</i>	Modified rules will be used for ALL Band A contests regardless of the age of the players involved.
