Incorporated into the workshop is Basic Long Term Player Development, this is designed to give coaches and parents an over view of the LTPD and provide information on more in-depth training resources.

Places are strictly limited to 20 places. This course has proved very popular in the past and early booking is advisable.

This is a 4-hour evening workshop and suitable for Coach revalidation

Attendance at a SPC workshop is mandatory for all players looking to newly qualify as coaches. Existing coaches will need to have attended a SPC course in order to Coach.
