### **Responsibility and Remit**

1. Strategic Planning and formulation of all policy and procedures for the Association and the sport to ensure every person in the UK has the opportunity to participate in or support the sport of judo from grassroots through to High Performance level.
2. The supervision and control of all technical matters.
3. The overall responsibility for the business affairs of the Association.
4. Agreeing and reviewing quality standards for all areas of the core business of the BJA.
5. The review and approval of annual budgets and accounts. Bottom line fiscal responsibility.
6. The timely and comprehensive dissemination of relevant information to Members Clubs and Licence Holders.
7. To liaise with the EJU, IJF, UK Sport, Sport England, UKSI, EIS, BOA, BOMC, Sport Scotland, WSC, and others as appropriate to further our stated objectives of developing the sport of judo at all levels.
8. The appointment of Commissions with or without power to act on behalf of the Board of Directors.
9. The overall control of all gradings and the awarding of all Dan Grades using established criteria.
10. To ensure the future of the Association by exercising sound financial controls and continuously assessing and updating the Risk Management policies.
