

INTRODUCTION

The grading scheme documents are reviewed on an annual basis. Following a review after the current document has been in use for almost 1 year there have been some important additions and also a number of minor changes have also been made. These are mainly to correct typographical errors and ambiguities. There has also been added, greater clarification to the instructions. The individual waza have not been changed and to assist the reader of the revised syllabus the main changes are listed as follows.

CHANGES

Front Page: A revision date has been added. A master list of dates for all grading documents will be posted on the web page.

Page 2: Addition to the Technical paragraph, with detailed instructions on submitting final documentation to NDGR.

Page 5: Addition to notes on point scoring competitions indicating that 1st Kyus must be a minimum age of 15.

Page 8: Addition of Competitive Dan Grading Guidelines for VI judoka.

Page 9: Greater clarification of minimum age requirements.

Page 9: Addition of Special Needs Grading instructions.

Page 10: Addition of Technical Examination guidelines for examiner and candidate.

Page 11: General requirements have been amended to instruct examiners to ensure they have a copy of the Dan Grade syllabus and injury reporting form on each examining table. Also each mat to have a minimum of 1 qualified referee.
