Eligibility:	All competitors must hold a current BJA licence or a current licence from an Association affiliated to the BJA and produce it on the day of the event. All competitors must be aged over 8 and under 16 on the day of the event. Players other than novices must have been successfully graded during the last 12 months.	
Rules:	BJA rules will be strictly adhered to throughout the tournament. NO armlocks or strangles are permitted.

Junior competitors may only be entered into this event if they live within one of the East Midlands Counties or if they are registered with a judo club located within the East Midlands. The East Midlands region includes the following counties: Lincolnshire, Derbyshire, Northants, Leicestershire & Rutland, Nottinghamshire.
