Categories

GROUP A: ♦ Boys 6th Mon (Yellow Belt) & Below ♦ Girls 6th Mon (Yellow Belt) & Below

All players will be weighed in and sorted into groups of 4 or 5 by weight, grade and age, so that, for example, younger heavier players are not disadvantaged. All players will receive a medal.

All players from GROUP A will then be automatically entered in GROUP B (No need to re-weigh)

GROUP B: ♦ Boys 12th Mon (Green Belt) & Below ♦ Girls 12th Mon (Green Belt) & Below

All players will be weighed in and sorted into groups of (usually) 8. Each group will be two pools of four into semi-finals and finals. There will be four medals in each weight category (Medals of a higher standard than in GROUP A).

And then, in case you haven't had enough, (as far as possible) all players will go into GROUP C.

GROUP C: Team Categories (12th Mon (Green Belt) & Below)

♦ Boys Lightweights: 3 players, total weight under 100kg. ♦ Girls Lightweights: 3 players, total weight under 100kg.

♦ Boys Heavyweights: 3 players, 1 each in -42, -48, -55kg. ♦ Girls Heavyweights: 3 players, 1 each in -42, -48, -55kg.

Clubs with places short can borrow from and swap with other clubs. Players without a team can be sorted into scratch teams to ensure maximum participation. We anticipate that almost everybody can take part.

In GROUPS B & C a weight allowance will be given for lower graded players as follows:

♦ Red Belts: deduct 3kg ♦ Yellow Belts: deduct 2kg ♦ Orange Belts: deduct 1kg

Eg. A LW team with 2 red & 1 orange belts may weigh 106kg. A HW team's 44kg yellow belt player will be deemed 42kg.

GROUP D: ♦ Boys Open Category (Green Belt & Below) ♦ Girls Open Category (Green Belt & Below)

This will be generally for players too heavy for teams, but will be open to any player +50kg including those in teams.

Most players will therefore have at least 2, possibly 3 and maybe 4 chances to win medals. **Can you get the hat-trick?**

Weigh-In

♦ GROUP A Boys: 9am - 9:30am ♦ A Girls: 10am - 10:30am ♦ GROUP B Boys*: 11:30am - 12noon ♦ B Girls*: 12:30pm - 1pm

*those who aren't already in GROUP A. Those in GROUP A need not reweigh. Team events will follow individual event.

Notes

All competitors must be over 8 and under 16 years of age on the day; must possess a valid, in date BJA licence or equivalent and must wear white judogi with blue or white belt (belts supplied). Non-BJA members' grades should not exceed the colours stated. All players except novices should have entered a grading in the last 9 months.

Two Star Tournament Licence. We want genuine minimons, no gong hunters. No 2007 national medallists of any association. Clubs with a history of sending extremely under graded players to events will have their entries returned.

BJA technical restrictions (U12) will apply in GROUP A and Lightweight teams in GROUP C irrespective of age.

BJA technical restrictions will not apply in GROUPS B, GROUPS D and Heavyweight teams in GROUP C.

Please note that substantial use will be made of qualified and experienced junior referees.

Abuse of any referees or officials or any attempt to pressurise referees will not be allowed.

♦ Entry fee: £15 per player; £16 if paid on the day. ♦ Closing date for entries: 24th May or when event is full.
