Incorporated into the workshop is Basic orientation for the BJA's Long Term Player Development Plan (LTPD), this is designed to give coaches and parents an over view of the plan and provide information on more in-depth training resources.

This is a 4-hour workshop and will be a BJA coach revalidation event.

Attendance at a SPC workshop is mandatory for all players looking to newly qualify as coaches. Existing coaches will need to have attended a SPC course in order to obtain the UK Coaching Certificate.
