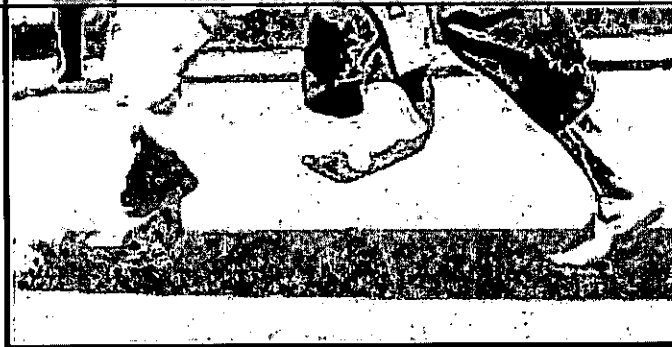


NORTHBROOK KYU SHIN KAI INTERNATIONAL JUDO OPEN

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All contests will be fought under BJA CONTEST rules.
2. Arm locks and Strangles **WILL NOT** be permitted in any junior contests above. Senior contest will be subject to the full BJA contest rules.
3. In the absence of corner judges the referee's decision will be final. Any enquiries should be made by the team coach/ manager only. To the mat marshal Mr Richard Raymond sensei or the senior referee Mr Albert Currier.
4. Closing date: All entries must reach us by the last post on **FRIDAY 13TH OCTOBER, 2006.**
5. Any entries received after this date or without sufficient funds **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED! – STRICTLY NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY!**
6. Weigh-in will be strictly controlled, with one weigh-in only (only removal of jacket permitted).

ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE PERMITTED TO WEIGH IN BETWEEN 6PM AND 7PM AT THE WHITE OAKS LEISURE CENTRE, SWANLEY, KENT BR8 8BT ON SATURDAY 21ST OCTOBER

7. Weigh-in changes where a judoka goes up in weight on the day will be **subject to a £2 penalty** – this rule will be strictly enforced, please make sure judoka from your clubs are aware of this rule (there will be no weight changes downwards).
8. The Northbrook Kyu Shin Kai advocates a rule of **NO COACHING**, coaches please be aware that any coaching could harm your judokas chances
9. No refreshments, drinks, etc. to be taken into the contest hall. Water will be made available at the mat-side, for competitors.
10. The competition organisers reserve the right to amalgamate any weight categories, were numbers may be insufficient.
11. Where there are sufficient numbers categories will be fought in preliminary round pools, then by knockout.
12. Where possible 4 medals (Gold, Silver and 2 bronze medals) will be awarded in contests, where it is not possible only 3 medals will be awarded (Gold, Silver and 1 x Bronze medal).
13. Entry fee: **£8 Primaries and Juniors and £10 for seniors**
14. Cheques made payable to **NORTHBROOK JUDO CLUB**, c.o 155 DOWNDERRY Road, Downham, Bromley, Kent BR1 5QE (Tel: Albert on 0208 698 8792).
15. Primaries should be younger than 10 years of age on the day of entry; proof of age will be necessary (licence, etc).
16. Judoka entering the senior categories must be 16 years or over on the day of entry
17. In the event of an individual contest having no score those contests will then be decided on a "GOLDEN SCORE" rule, then by Hantei, if still no score is decided.
18. **IMPORTANT** – Entrants must produce a current licence on the day of entry that provides insurance e.g. BJC, BJA, BJC (MAC), IBF or AJA. The Northbrook Judo club.
