## Preparation and Guideline Notes

### Preliminary Club Coach Award

#### Minimum Requirements

- ✓ Minimum Grade of BJA 4thKyu
- ✓ Minimum of 17 years old
- ✓ Have attended a BJA preparation course
- ✓ Hold a current BJA licence
- ✓ Hold a current basic First Aid Certificate.

#### **Part 1.**

The candidate will be required to demonstrate 10 techniques a minimum of 5 will be throws. The techniques will be from the Junior grading syllabus and the Senior grading syllabus up to 4<sup>th</sup> Kyu. The techniques will be of the examiners choice.

Marking will range from 0 to 10 points for each technique. Please refer to the Marking Guidelines document in your folder for more details.

Minimum pass mark is 70%

#### **Part 1b**

The candidate will be required to demonstrate knowledge of Japanese terminology through translation to English. The terminology will be 10 words of the examiners choice taken from the Junior and Senior grading syllabi.

Minimum Pass Mark 80%

#### **Part 2.**

##### Practical Coaching

The candidate will be required to demonstrate the ability to run a 15-20 minute session teaching one Tachi Waza and one Ne Waza technique . The techniques will be selected by the examiner from the Junior grading syllabus and the Senior syllabus up to 4<sup>th</sup> Kyu.

The Candidate will be marked on the following points:-

	Possible mark
a. Introduction	5%
b. Technique	35%
c. Progression	15%
d. Clarity of Instruction	15%
e. Presence	15%
f. Imagination	15%

Minimum Pass Mark 60% each for the Tachi Waza and Ne Waza Sections.

### **Part 3a**

#### Rules and Refereeing:-

The candidate must demonstrate an ability to referee upto three senior contests.

Candidates will be marked on the following points:-

Minimum Pass Mark 50%

### **Part 3b**

#### Rules and Refereeing:-

The candidate must answer a 10 question multi choice paper and a 10 question oral refereeing and rules questionnaire.

Pass Mark for each paper 50%

Any candidate who holds a current BJA Referee Award is exempt from Parts 3A & 3B

Information on current rules should be sourced form the IJF Contest Rules as adopted by the BJA.
