

Use of Photographic and Filming equipment at Competitions and events

The British Judo Association is committed to providing a safe environment for children/young people under the age of 18. Essential to this commitment, is to ensure that all necessary steps are taken to protect children/young people from the inappropriate use of their images in resource and media publications, on the Internet, and elsewhere.

There have been concerns about the risks posed directly and indirectly to children and young people through the use of photographs on judo web sites and other publications.

As part of our child protection procedures the BJA has introduced a registration system for people wishing to take images at judo events.

One of the main problems encountered by people has been the need to re-register for each event at which they wish to film/photograph. To help ease the workload for event organisers and make the process easier for the photographers the BJA has decided to issue a 3-year Video/Photography pass.

At present these passes are not mandatory and people will still be able to register with the event organiser on the day of an event.

Whilst the BJA does not want to charge for the pass itself we will require a fee of £1.50 as a contribution to the postage costs involved in processing the documents required. This fee can be paid by cheque, postal orders or in the form of stamps.

It must be stressed that this pass does not give you permission to video any child you wish. You must still follow the guidelines laid out on our web site in the child protection area www.britishjudo.org.uk.
