	Group 2	<p>Minimum age 12 years Under 16 years on the day</p> <p>Boys -34kg -38kg -42kg -46kg -50kg -55kg -60kg -66kg -73kg +73kg Girls -32kg -36kg -40kg -44kg -48kg -52kg -57kg -63kg +63kg</p>
	Group 3	<p>Minimum age 15 years</p> <p>Men -60kg -66kg -73kg -81kg -90kg -100kg +100kg Women -48kg -52kg -57kg -63kg -70kg -78kg +78kg</p>
	<p>Players can only move up a weight group if there are less than 3 in the group</p> <p>Players can only compete in another group if there are less than 3 in their group and any medal will not count towards the trophy</p>	
Competition Format, Rules and Judogi Rules	<p>Mat side coaching rule will be permitted throughout the event One coach, who must remain seated, is allowed per competitor</p> <p>The wearing of white judogi is compulsory for this event; no blue judogi</p> <p>Medals will be presented as soon as the weight category is completed, and the necessary paperwork is available</p>	

	<p>This is a level three points scoring tournament. BJA rules will apply throughout the event in accordance with the BJA Tournament Handbook</p> <p>The decision of the Tournament Director will be final</p>
