Eligibility	<p>All competitors must hold a valid BJA, BJC or AJA licence and must present this when booking in on the day of the event.</p> <p>All competitors must be aged 14 years or over, wear a white judogi and provide their own blue and white belts.</p> <p>Those holding non-BJA grades should not hold grades above the colours stated.</p> <p>Points scoring for 1st Kyu players and above. Where possible, additional categories will be created to maximise points scoring opportunities.</p>
Categories	<p>A: Cadets (Players aged 14-17 years inclusive): Entries will be grouped by standard cadet weight categories where possible.</p> <p>B: Seniors Blue Belt & Below (players aged 14+ years): Entries will be grouped by standard senior weight categories where possible.</p> <p>C: Seniors Brown Belt & Above (players aged 14+ years): Entries will be grouped by standard senior weight categories where possible.</p>
Method of Elimination	<p>Pools and Pools to Knockout.</p> <p>The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine or alter categories if entries dictate.</p>
Weigh-In	<p>Category A Male & All Females – 8.30am to 8.50am</p> <p>Category B Male – 10.30am to 10.50am</p> <p>Category C Male – 12.30pm to 12.50pm</p> <p>All competitors MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a plain white, round neck t-shirt / rash guard, a 0.8kg allowance will be given for this.</p>
