Eligibility:	All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA, Judo Scotland, BJC or AJA. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation Minors: Year of birth 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 only – minimum grade – yellow belt (4th Mon) – minimum age - 8 years on the day Pre-cadet: Year of birth 2012 and 2013 only – minimum grade – yellow belt (6th Mon) Cadet: Year of birth 2009, 2010 or 2011 – minimum grade - green belt (10th Mon/3rd Kyu) It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete. Competitors who are entering a category which is different to their sex assigned at birth are requested to contact safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk at the earliest opportunity.
Competition Format:	Knockout with Compound Repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout. The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook. This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes. IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following; <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No 30 second rule• BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to Minors categories. <u>The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event;</u> any competitors choosing to wear Blue Judogi must also have a white Judogi when required. Competitors should bring their own white and blue belts for competition use.

Registrations and Weigh-In:	<p>The official weigh-in will take place on Saturday 11th April 2026</p> <p>All Cadets - 08:15am – 08.45am</p> <p>All Minors - 11:00am – 11:30am</p> <p>All Pre-Cadets – 12noon – 12.30pm</p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo licence/membership to registration and also their record book showing their grade (valid digital versions accepted).</p> <p>An Open weigh in will be conducted at this event therefore ALL competitors must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt, (a 0.8kg allowance will be given).</p> <p>Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, i.e. for u73kg players must weigh over 66.8kg.</p> <p>All Cadets who compete at the Saturday event and are competing in the Junior event on the Sunday must register and weigh-in for the Junior event during the allocated times but they will not be required to make their weight category limit but should be within 5% of the maximum weight limit for their weight category.</p> <p>Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.</p> <p>The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area (except if required for membership/grade proof).</p> <p>Please note: Test scales will be available at registration (where the officials must be notified of any weight category changes).</p> <p>Players can change weight categories during the registration process (weight changes must take place prior to the player stepping on the official weigh in scales).</p>

Matside Coaching/Coaching Passes:	<p>Coaching passes may be obtained at the Safeguarding Desk. Only one coach should be matside per player at any one time</p>
