<b>Participation</b>	Competitors must hold current Welsh Judo Association licence. No other national governing body membership will be accepted. All competitors must bring their valid judo membership to registration.		
<b>Category: Adults</b>	Nage-no-kata  Go-no-sen-no-kata	Katame-no-kata  Itsutsu-no-kata	Ju-no-kata
<b>Category: Youth</b>  <b>Aged under 16 on the day.</b>	Nage-no-kata (first 3 sets only)	Katame-no-kata (first 2 sets only)	Ju-no-kata (first set only)
<b>Booking in &amp; registration:</b>	Sunday 10 August All Adults kata: 09:00 – 09:30 All Youth kata: 13:00 – 13:30		
<b>Standards &amp; Judogi Rules:</b>	The reference standard for all kata is the relevant Kodokan teaching film.  Participants must strictly wear <b>white judogi</b> only.		
<b>Assessment:</b>	The EJU and IJF kata tournament marking system will not be used for this tournament. Each technique will be scored out of 10, with 10 representing a perfect execution, and 0 given for an omitted or totally incorrect technique. There will be additional marks out of 10 for opening and closing etiquette.  Competitors are allowed to participate in each kata only once, and only in one age category per kata.		
<b>Closing Date for Entries</b>	<b>Friday 01 August 2025</b> Telephone, postal or email entries will not be accepted.  Please note that entry may close before the above date if event reaches maximum participant capacity.		
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<b>Adult Kata</b> £20 per pair  <b>Youth Kata</b> £14 per pair	Competitors are allowed to participate in each kata only once, and only in one age category per kata.
