Competition Format:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is a British Judo Level Three event • BJA rules will apply throughout the event and will be in accordance with the Tournament Handbook. The decision of the Tournament Director will be final. • The method of competition will be pools into Compound Repechage • The final format will be decided by the tournament director dependent on entry numbers and the overall event timetable. • Only registered coaches with a valid coaching card will be allowed a matside coaching pass to coach. • The Tournament Director has the right to combine weight categories when there are insufficient entries in any weight group • Medals to be awarded to the top four medallists
Weight Categories:	Boys: -27kg, -30kg, -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, O60kg, Girls: -28kg, -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, O57kg Technical Restrictions will apply to all weight groups <i>* Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, ie for -55kg must weigh over 50.8kg</i>

An open weigh-in will take place at this event, all competitors will receive a 0.8kg allowance. Please note that due to this, ALL competitors will receive the weight allowance. ALL competitors MUST weigh in wearing their competition judogi trousers and white round neck t-shirt.</p> <p>Competitors are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.</p>
