An Open British Judo Association Level 3 Point Scoring Event

Date: Saturday 6th December 2025

Venue: Goodwin Sports Centre, Northumberland Road, Sheffield, S10 2TY

Eligibility

This is an open kyu grade senior event. Competitors will be required to produce a valid, in date **FULL** BJA licence. Recreational and pay as you throw licences are not valid for competition Mon grades should enter the equivalent senior colour grade for that section All competitors must have graded within the last 12 months (excluding 1st Kyu) and grade recorded in record book (licence).

Categories

- Novice 5th kyu (white yellow belt)
- 4th 2nd kyu (orange blue belt)
- 1st kyu (brown belt) **point scoring**

Weigh in

Weigh in times will be published in due course on the event website.

Anticipate low grades first up to higher grades later.

Men	U66, U73, U81, U90, O90
Women	U57, U63, U70, O70
We reserve the right to merge weight groups if necessary	

All weigh ins are open, therefore players are to weigh in wearing Judogi trousers and a t-shirt. All players have a 0.8Kg allowance for clothing.
