<b>VENUE:</b>	The Herts and Essex Sports Centre, Beldams Lane, Bishops Stortford, Hertfordshire. CM23 5LH
<b>PARTICIPATION:</b>	<p>All competitors <b>MUST</b> have a <b>VALID</b> BJA or affiliate judo membership, and their grade must be correctly registered with BJA or affiliate.</p> <p>Competitors <b>MUST</b> be aged between <b>8 and 15 years</b> on the day of the event and be a maximum grade of <b>3<sup>rd</sup> Mon/ 6<sup>th</sup> Kyu</b>.</p> <p>Competitors <b>MUST</b> be a and have graded within 6 months prior to the event.</p> <p>Novice competitors <b>MUST</b> have held a judo membership for no longer than <b>6 months</b> prior to the event.</p> <p>Competitors that need to change groups due to a change grade after entering <b>MUST</b> inform the competition controller prior to the event.</p>
<b>SAFEGUARDING:</b>	Competitors who are entering a category which is different to their sex assigned at birth are requested to contact <a href="mailto:safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk">safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk</a> at the earliest opportunity.
<b>GROUPS:</b>	<p><b>Group 1</b> – Girls 8 to 11yrs, Novice to 3<sup>rd</sup> Mon</p> <p><b>Group 2</b> – Girls 12 to 15yrs, Novice to 3<sup>rd</sup> Mon/ 6<sup>th</sup> Kyu</p> <p><b>Group 3</b> – Boys 8 to 11yrs, Novice to 1<sup>st</sup> Mon</p> <p><b>Group 4</b> – Boys 8 to 11yrs, 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Mon</p> <p><b>Group 5</b> – Boys, 12 to 15yrs, Novice to 3<sup>rd</sup> Mon/ 6<sup>th</sup> Kyu</p>
<b>REGISTRATION &amp; WEIGH IN:</b>	<p><b>Groups 1 &amp; 2 Girls: 9:00am    Group 5 Boys: 11:00am    Group 4 Boys: 12:30pm    Group 3 Boys: 2:00pm</b></p> <p>All competitors <b>MUST</b> bring their <b>VALID</b> judo membership card to registration with their record book, which shows they meet the age and grade requirements.</p> <p>All competitors will take part in an <b>OPEN</b> weigh in, wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and crew neck t-shirt/ rash guard.</p> <p><b>Please note weight-in times may be modified to minimise time between weigh-in and competing. In the event of a change all entrants will be notified at least one week before the event.</b></p>
<b>EVENT FORMAT:</b>	<p>All competitors will receive a medal.</p> <p>Competitors will be weighed on the day and put into pools; based on gender, age, weight and grade.</p> <p>Dependent on the entry some groups may be merged, this will be at the discretion of the tournament director and club coaches.</p>
<b>CONTEST RULES:</b>	Current BJA rules will be in operation. <b>BJA Technical Restrictions will apply in ALL Groups.</b>
<b>JUDOGI RULES:</b>	<p>Competitors <b>MUST</b> wear a <b>white judogi</b> (blue judogi not permitted).</p> <p>Girls <b>MUST</b> wear a plain white crew neck t-shirt/ rash guard, boys may opt to.</p>
<b>ENTRY FEE:</b>	<p><b>£25.00</b> per competitor</p> <p>Entry Fees are <b>NON-REFUNDABLE</b>, unless tournament is cancelled.</p> <p>Online entries only.</p>
