



# BISHOPS STORTFORD JUDO

## Yellow, Orange & Green Belt U16 Championships

**Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2026**

<b>VENUE:</b>	The Herts and Essex Sports Centre, Beldams Lane, Bishops Stortford, Hertfordshire. CM23 5LH
<b>PARTICIPATION:</b>	All competitors MUST have a VALID BJA or affiliate judo membership, and their grade must be correctly registered with BJA or affiliate. Competitors MUST be aged between <b>8 and 15 years</b> on the day of the event. Minimum grade <b>4<sup>th</sup> Mon/ 5<sup>th</sup> Kyu</b> , maximum grade <b>12<sup>th</sup> Mon/ 3<sup>rd</sup> Kyu</b> .
<b>SAFEGUARDING:</b>	Competitors who are entering a category which is different to their sex assigned at birth are requested to contact <a href="mailto:safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk">safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk</a> at the earliest opportunity.
<b>GROUPS:</b>	<b>Group 1 – Girls 8 to 11yrs: Yellow, Orange &amp; Green Belts (4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Mon):</b> -28kg, -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, U52kg, +52kg <b>Group 2 – Girls 12 to 15yrs: Yellow, Orange &amp; Green Belts (4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Mon/ 5<sup>th</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Kyu):</b> -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, +63kg <b>Group 3 – Boys 8 to 11yrs: Yellow, Orange &amp; Green Belts (4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Mon):</b> -27kg, -30kg, -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, U50kg, +50kg <b>Group 4 – Boys 12 to 15yrs: Yellow, Orange &amp; Green Belts (4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Mon/ 5<sup>th</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> Kyu):</b> -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, +66kg
<b>REGISTRATION &amp; WEIGH IN:</b>	<b>Groups 1 &amp; 2: Girls: 9:00am    Group 4: Boys 12-15yrs: 11:00am    Group 3: Boys 8-11yrs: 12:00noon</b> All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo membership card to registration with their record book, which shows they meet the age and grade requirements. All competitors will take part in an OPEN weigh in, wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and crew neck t-shirt/ rash guard. <b>Please note weight-in times may be modified to minimise time between weigh-in and competing. In the event of a change all entrants will be notified at least one week before the event.</b>
<b>EVENT FORMAT:</b>	Top 4 placed competitors will receive a medal. The method of elimination for this event will be compound knockout with double repechage for 8 competitors or more, 7 competitors or less will be pools. Contest durations will be 3 minutes for all groups. Dependent on the entry some groups may be merged, this will be at the discretion of the tournament director and club coaches.
<b>CONTEST RULES:</b>	Current BJA rules will be in operation. <b>BJA Technical Restrictions will apply in groups 1 and 3.</b>
<b>JUDOGI RULES:</b>	Competitors MUST wear a <b>white judogi</b> (blue judogi not permitted). Girls MUST wear a plain white crew neck t-shirt/ rash guard, boys may opt to.
<b>ENTRY FEE:</b>	<b>£25.00</b> per competitor. Entry Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE, unless tournament is cancelled. Online entries only.

<b>CLOSING DATE:</b>	Closing date for entries is <b>Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2026</b> (or when the entry limit is reached).

<b>COACHES:</b>	Coaches must produce a VALID BJA or affiliate Coach Card (with MATSIDE award) to gain matside access. Only one coach per contest area will be permitted matside at any one time. If your coach licence is not valid there is no matside coaching.
