**Venue:** Stevenson Building, University of Glasgow, 77 Oakfield Avenue, Glasgow G12 8LT

**Date:** Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> of April 2026

**Closing date:** all entries must be received by **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026 5pm. No late entries will be accepted.**

**Eligibility:** All players must hold a senior license, either Judo Scotland or affiliated membership.

## **Weight Categories:**

Mixed teams of **Any grade:**

Female: u63kgs, o63kgs

Male: u73kgs, u81kgs, u90kgs, o90kgs

- Clubs may enter as many teams as they wish.
- Any teams with spaces can 'shop' for players from reserves on the day.
- Teams may have up to two reserves, weight category specified.
- Reserves may fight in their specified weight category or any higher category (within safe limits, at the discretion of the tournament director).

## **Entry Fee:**

£110 per team. Entry fees are not refundable.

## **Medals:**

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded.

#### Judogi:

Competitors may compete in white or blue coloured judogi as long as it fits in accordance with the current BJA contest rules on judogi control. Players should bring their own blue & white belts if possible.

All players may opt to wear a t-shirt under their judogi. The t-shirt must comply with the current BJA judogi control rules, although non-white t-shirts will be accepted.
