Judogi Rules	All competitors will wear a judogi, not BJJ/Karate etc. ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEIGH IN IN A T-SHIRT AND GI BOTTOMS (optional for boys to fight in t-shirts under judogi, please use the changing rooms to get changed) All Judogi must fit correctly.
Contest Rules	ALL categories will be run with technical restrictions.
	Contests shall be 3 minutes for the Mon competition.

Competition Format	All competitors will be weighed on the day and grouped into Pools depending on gender , age , weight , and grade . Using the index system (Age x2+grade+weight). All efforts will be made to find a suitable group for each competitor, the Tournament Director will consult coaches/parents if any suitable matches can't be found (anyone without a group will be informed and refunded). If required age groups may be merged (within reason), coaches and competitors will be consulted the week of the competition date of any issues.
