Eligibility:

This is a **development** event limited to judoka age 8 years old to 15 years old.

Red Belts - Novice to 3rd Mon, Yellow Belts - 4th Mon - 6th Mon Orange belts 7th Mon - 9th Mon.

All Novice competitors must have held a licence for no longer than 9 months. Yellow and Orange Belt competitors must have been graded within the last 9 months.

Please check that all competitors meet the eligibility criteria and that the correct grade is reflected in their judo licence.

Competitors MUST produce a valid BJA or affiliated association membership card and record book at weigh in, failure to produce a valid membership card and proof of grade will mean no participation – no refund of entry fees.

NO VALID LICENCE - NO CONTEST - NO EXCEPTIONS

Format:

Players will be grouped into pools of 4/5/6 players of their weight, where possible, based on the age/grade groups below. However, some groups may need to be merged, and in these instances, it will discuss with the coaches of the affected players.

All competitors participating in this event are required to wear a **WHITE** judo Gi jacket and trousers.

Medals will be presented after each group, where possible, and all competitors will receive a medal for competing.

If a player is graded and this grading leads to a change in the competitors belt colour, you must inform the competition organizer via email before the event as this can change group sizes and could mean a change of weigh in time for the player.

Only accredited coaches are allowed mat side when their players are competing, and we kindly ask that you produce your coach licence for verification if asked by any official.
