GROUP A: Men +35 years green belt & below:	-66	-73	-81	-90	+90 kg
GROUP B: Men +35 years blue & brown belt:	-66	-73	-81	-90	+90 kg
GROUP C: Men green belt & below:	-66	-73	-81	-90	+90 kg
GROUP D: Men blue & brown belt:	-66	-73	-81	-90	+90 kg

Open categories for 1st kyu players may be held at the end if time available.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are an experienced BJJ player or similar but do not hold a judo grade, DO NOT enter the green & below sections. These are for genuine inexperienced players. If in doubt, email us to discuss.

#### Weigh-In

All weigh-in times will be posted on the club website and Facebook page a week before the event or when we have all the entries in. The first weigh-in will not start until 9.30 am. Players weigh in wearing judogi bottoms, for which 0.8 kg allowance is given. (T-shirt also optional).

#### Notes

We reserve the right to combine or alter categories if entries dictate.

All competitors must hold BJA membership or equivalent & must be at least 14 years of age (Groups

C&D) or 35 years of age (Groups A&B).
Players +35 years can enter both age bands — no additional entry fee.
Mon grades should enter the equivalent senior colour grade for that section. Those holding non-BJA grades should also enter the equivalent colour grade section.
Competition will be pools, K.O. & repechage. BJA Level Three event, point scoring for 1st kyus.

#### Entry

Entry fee: £17 per player. NO entries on the day. Spectators free. Closing date for entries: March 14 or when event is full. This event will be oversubscribed, so early entry is advised.

Please ensure that ALL required information is on your entry. Email us if for any reason it is not.
