

## SENIOR EXAMINER REVALIDATION REQUIREMENTS

Senior Examiners (SEs) must revalidate every THREE (3) years by keeping their coaching qualification valid and conducting a minimum of TWO (2) Dan grade promotion examinations and attending an Examiners' conference.

If an SE fails to revalidate, they will not lose their qualification; it will be set aside and they will not be able to carry out any type of Dan grading. They can be reinstated through an Area Director of Examiners (ADofE) referral, by conducting a promotion examination under supervision to the satisfaction of the ADofE.

SEs should familiarise themselves with the latest rule changes when they become available from the IJF/BJA

All SEs must keep up to date with current BJA refereeing rules and it is recommended that all SEs attend a refereeing course, seminar, workshop or rules update course at least once in their three-year revalidation period.

From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2029 all SEs will be required to have BJA Level 2 certificates in both Nage-no-kata and Katame-no-kata.
