

SENIOR EXAMINER REQUIREMENTS

Those candidates wishing to become a Senior Examiner (SE) must meet the following requirements:

- Hold a valid Full British Judo Association membership.
- Hold a British Judo Association (BJA) grade of Competitive or Technical 3rd Dan. Applicants holding the earlier non-competitive grade of 3rd Dan should transfer to a Technical grade of 3rd Dan.
- Complete the refereeing theory examination to National C level.
- Hold a current minimum Level 2 coaching award.
- Be certified to BJA Level 2 in Nage-no-kata and Katame-no-kata.
- Sit in at a minimum four Dan grade examinations, each with a minimum number of six candidates.
- Conduct under supervision four Dan grade examinations, each with a minimum number of six candidates.
- Be competent to examine Competitive Skills and Technical Dan Grade examinations (ratified by the ADofE).
- Undertake training, overseen by the ADofE, to a set national standard including booking in, recording points on examination sheets, completion of points card etc.

Appointment

On completion of all requirements, the Area Director of Examiners (ADofE) will certify this in writing by completing the application form and record of training, and sending all the forms to the National Dan Grading Manager (NDGM).

The National Promotions and Gradings Commission (NPGC) will check the criteria with the National Dan Grade Administrator (NDGA) and will then approve the appointment and issue the current documentation and blazer badge.

General

The SE serves to maintain the quality of the Dan grades within the BJA. It is a respected qualification as it requires significant commitment to obtain and maintain validity.

The ADofE is responsible for maintaining appropriate levels of SE holders in their Area and there may be a waiting list for new SEs before starting practical training.
