**Group 1: U8 Festival:** start time- 10am

- Ages: 5, 6 or 7 years old (on the day of the competition)
- Format: The participants will be guided through a warm up, fun activities, practice of breakfalls and simple throws. Following this they will be put into groups of 3 or 4 based on their weights, age and grade – within these groups they will participate in competitive competition guided by the coaches.
- Everyone will receive a participation medal.

**Group 2: Red,Yellow,Orange Belt:** start time – 11am

- Ages: 8-12 years old (on the day of the competition)
- Format: All players will be put in groups of 3 or 4 based on weights, ages and grade given by coaches. The event will consist of a group warm up and explanation of competition rules and etiquette. The event is a development event, as such no shido's will be given but players will be stopped and rules explained if they infringe them. Contest time 2 minutes.

- Everyone will receive a medal.

### Coach Rating:

All coaches will need to attach a rating to player 1-3 (1= needs looking after, 2= average club player, 3= mini ninja). To insure the groups are fair and enjoyable as possible.
