Competition Format:	<p>Categories will be fought in pools (or pools/knockout depending on numbers entered).</p> <p>The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.</p> <p>Contest time: 4 mins</p> <p>There will be one Gold medal, one Silver medal and one/two Bronze medals (depending on number in group) presented in each group.</p> <p>This tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>The wearing of a WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event</u></p>
Weight Categories:	<p>All Dan Grades and 1st Kyu Grades (Brown Belts)</p> <p>Male -60kgs, -66kgs, -73kgs, -81kgs, -90kgs, -100kgs, +100kgs</p> <p>Female -48kgs, -52kgs, -57kgs, -63kgs, -70kgs, -78kgs, +78kgs</p> <p>(STRANGLES AND ARMSOCKS PERMITTED IN ALL CATEGORIES)</p> <p>Shinsei Judo Club reserves the right to amalgamate adjacent weight categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories.</p> <p>Kyu Grades</p> <p>There are no set weight categories. All players will be sorted into groups based on weight and grade depending on entries.</p> <p>Kyu Grades will be sorted into the following categories (depending on entry numbers)</p> <p>Middle Kyu – 2nd & 3rd (Blue & Green Belts) Kyu grades</p> <p>Lower Kyu – 4th 5th 6th Kyu grades (Orange, Yellow, Red and White Belts)</p>
Registration and Weigh-In:	<p>Sunday 1st March 2026</p> <p>All Dan Grades and 1st Kyu Grades – 08.30am to 9.00am</p> <p>Middle and Lower Kyu Grades – 12 noon to 12.30pm (may be subject to change depending on entries)</p> <p>An open weigh in will take place at this event therefore all players must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt (plain white round neck if wearing a t-shirt when competing).</p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo membership/licence to registration and also their Record Book showing their grade. Digital memberships must be able to be accessed to show valid date and member's grade.</p> <p>Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.</p> <p>The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area (except to access a digital membership).</p>
