Eligibility	<p>This is a Level 0.5 development event for judoka under 12 years of age. Children must be aged 8-11 on the day to enter.</p> <p>Competitors must be Novice-3rd Mon on the day. If a player has been graded since completing the entry form, you must contact the event organisers.</p> <p>Competitors must produce a valid BJA or affiliated association membership card and record book at weigh in. Failure to produce a valid membership card and proof of grade will mean no participation – no refund of entry fees.</p>

Format	<p>Players will be grouped into pools of 3/4/5 on the day where possible, based on their age, weight, grade and sex.</p> <p>All competitors participating in this event are required to wear a white judogi jacket and trousers.</p>
