Please state exact weight of your players on entry form
- Group C:** over 16 and all adults  
Please state exact weight (**Armlocks and strangles permitted**)

We will try to provide as many matches as possible on a day. All players will receive medal. We will try to match grades as closely as possible.

**Group B:** 10am-10.15am  
**Group C:** 11+
