<b>Eligibility:</b>	<b>Seniors</b> Open to all senior players who are at least 14 years old and who are 2 <sup>nd</sup> kyu and below, including novice (white belt) grades as long as they have a valid full license on the day.
<b>Weight/Grade Categories:</b>	<b>Weight</b> All competitors will be weighed in and categories will be made to suit pools where possible. <b>Categories</b> <b>Male Weights:</b> -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg  <b>Female Weights:</b> -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg  Novice (white belt) to 5th kyu (yellow belt) 4th kyu (orange belt) to 2nd kyu (blue belt)  <b>NOTE:</b> Weights/categories may be combined based on entry
<b>Entry Fee:</b>	<b>£25.00 Early Bird Entry closing 14<sup>th</sup> March</b> <b>£28.00 Standard from 15<sup>th</sup> March</b>  <b>Entry fees are not refundable.</b>

**Judogi:**

Competitors may compete in any colour of judogi as long as it fits in accordance with the current BJA contest rules on judogi control.

Players should bring their own blue & white belts if possible.

**All** players may opt to wear a t-shirt under their judogi. The t-shirt must comply with the current BJA judogi control rules, although non-white t-shirts will be accepted.

**Technical Restrictions:**

Novice to 5<sup>th</sup> Kyu — No strangles & Armlocks

No other technical restrictions will apply

**Coaching:**

Permitted through out and positive encouragement for all players is welcome.

**Weigh-In:**

Weigh-in times to be announced on social media after event closing.

We highly recommend novice to 5<sup>th</sup> kyu players attend early to watch the 4<sup>th</sup> kyu to 2<sup>nd</sup> kyu categories.

All competitors must wear contest judogi trousers to weigh-in.

**Officials**

Trainee officials will be used for this event under supervision. Please be conscious of this and make every effort to encourage their participation. Any player not eligible to compete is welcome to try timekeeping on the day, please let us know in advance if you are bringing any such players.
