PLAYERS - NOVICE TO 6rd MON or 6th and 5th KYU

BOYS: -24kg, -27kg, -30kg, -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, +60kg

GIRLS: -25kg, -28kg, -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, +57kg

ALL WEIGHTS - 08:15am to 09.00am

GROUP 2: AGED 8 – 15 YEARS INCLUSIVE

PLAYERS ORANGE & GREEN BELTS – 7th to 12th MON or 4th and 3rd KYU

BOYS: -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, +66kg

GIRLS: -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg

ALL WEIGHTS – 10:30am to 11:30am



GROUP 3: MINIMUM AGE 14

PLAYERS - NOVICE TO 4th KYU

MEN: -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg and +100kg

WOMEN: -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg and +70kg

ALL WEIGHTS - 12:30pm to 13.30pm

GROUP 4: MINIMUM AGE 14

PLAYERS - 3rd TO 1st KYU (Point scoring for 1st Kyu's)

MEN: -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg and +100kg

WOMEN: -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg and +70kg

ALL WEIGHTS - 12:30pm to 13.30pm

Competition Method: Compound Knockout – Numbers Permitting

The organisers reserve the right to combine weight groups should the entries warrant this.

Players aged 14 and over may enter both junior and senior categories – see below for double entry fee details

All competitors MUST weigh in wearing a plain white T-shirt and competition legal judogi trousers and will receive a 0.8kg allowance

One Club Coach per club per mat area will be permitted free entry on production of a VALID BJA Coach Award card

All other Club Coaches will be permitted a concession rate of £3 entry fee on production of a VALID BJA Coach Award Card

An Annual trophy, which can be engraved with the club name, will be awarded to club with the highest medal points on the day and a replica trophy will be given when the annual trophy is returned

Points will be awarded to clubs for each medal won as follows:.

***Gold 7 Points,
Silver 3 Point,
Bronze 1 point***

The following criteria will apply when awarding points for the trophy

<i>Pool of 6 Plus Players</i>	<i>-</i>	<i>Gold, Silver & 2 Bronze</i>
<i>Pool of 5 Players</i>	<i>-</i>	<i>Gold, Silver & 2 Bronze</i>
<i>Pool of 4 Players</i>	<i>-</i>	<i>Gold, Silver & 1 Bronze</i>
<i>Pool of 3 Players</i>	<i>-</i>	<i>Gold and Silver</i>
<i>Pool of 2 Players</i>	<i>-</i>	<i>Gold</i>

Where weight groups are combined in a pool, points will be awarded for the pool, i.e. 3rd place 1 point NOT 5 for a gold if only one in a weight category.

(The decision of the Tournament Director on awarding points in merged groups will be final
