Eligibility:	<p>All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA, Judo Scotland, BJC or AJA. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation</p> <p>Juniors: Year of birth 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011 – Contest time 4 mins - minimum grade – green belt (10th Mon/3rd Kyu) (all Cadets may also compete in the Junior category)</p> <p>Seniors: Year of birth – Minimum age of 14 years on day of competition – Contest time 4 mins – green belt (10th Mon/3rd Kyu)</p> <p>Veterans: Year of birth – Minimum age of 30 years on day of competition – Contest time 3 mins.</p> <p>Minimum grade – Green Belt</p> <p>It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.</p> <p>Competitors who are entering a category which is different to their sex assigned at birth are requested to contact safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk at the earliest opportunity.</p>
Competition Format:	<p>Knockout with Compound Repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout.</p> <p>The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.</p> <p>This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.</p> <p>IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No 30 second rule • BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to Minors categories. <p><u>The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event;</u> any competitors choosing to wear Blue Judogi must also have a white Judogi when required.</p> <p><u>Competitors should bring their own white and blue belts for competition use.</u></p>
Seeding:	Seeding for the Junior and Senior event will be based on the current GB Ranking list.

Registrations and Weigh-In:	<p>The official registration and weigh-in will take place –</p> <p><u>Sunday 12th April 2026</u></p> <p>Juniors - 8.00am to 8.30am (Test Scales available)</p> <p>Seniors - 8.30am to 9.00am (Test Scales available)</p> <p>Veterans - 11.00am to 11.30am (Test Scales available)</p> <p><u>Please note:</u> Competitors who are competing in both Junior and Senior or Senior and Veterans categories should collect both their registration cards and weigh in during the allocated Junior/Senior weigh in time.</p> <p>An open weigh in will be conducted at this event therefore <u>ALL</u> competitors must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt (a 0.8kg allowance will be given).</p> <p>Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category.</p> <p>All Cadets who competed at the Saturday event and are competing in the Junior event on the Sunday <u>must register and weigh-in for the Junior event</u> during the allocated time, they will not be required to make their weight category limit but should be within 5% of the maximum weight limit for their weight category.</p> <p>Test scales will be available at registration (where the officials must be notified of any weight category changes).</p> <p>Please note: No changes of weight category will be permitted after the player has weighed in on the official scales.</p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo licence/membership to registration and also their record book showing they meet the minimum grade requirement (valid digital versions accepted).</p> <p>The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area (except if required for membership/grade proof).</p>
