



## Peninsula Judo Spring Open

A British Judo Association Level One Tournament.

**Under 16 Orange Belt and Under.**

**This competition is aimed at the development of both players AND novice officials.**

<b>Date</b>	Sunday 22 <sup>nd</sup> March, 2026
<b>Venue</b>	Peninsula Judo, Plymstock School, Church Road, Plymstock, Plymouth, PL9 9AZ
<b>Eligibility</b>	All competitors should be between 8 and 15 years old.  All competitors must hold a current BJA licence, or a licence of an association affiliated to the BJA and produce it on the day of the event.
<b>Categories</b>	There will be NO weight categories. Judoka will be weighed and put into a pool of 4 maximum based on weight and grade. Categories will be single pools with all players receiving a medal.
<b>Competition Format</b>	All players MUST wear a white judogi.  British Judo Technical Restrictions will be used throughout this event. The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine or alter categories should the entries dictate.  The decision of the Tournament Director will be final.  <b>Coaches – Inform the Tournament Director of any players who may need consideration.</b>
<b>Contest Time</b>	3 Minutes (at the discretion of the Tournament Director)
<b>Weigh In</b>	All Competitors – To be confirmed nearer to the date.  All players MUST present themselves to weigh in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a PLAIN white t-shirt.
<b>Entry Fee</b>	Competitors - £15  Spectators - £1 per person, payable on the day
<b>Closing Date</b>	Sunday 15 <sup>th</sup> March, 2026 or when the maximum entry has been reached.
<b>Photography</b>	Please note that by entering or attending this competition you are agreeing to accept the BJA policy in respect of photography and video usage. The use of photographic equipment is permitted; however, should a request be made for you to stop, then you should respect the wishes of others. Any lights or flashes should be disabled prior to taking any photograph of action on a contest area.
