Venue parking is limited, paid for parking available at the NCP next door and at train station. We strongly recommend using the excellent Park & Ride service if driving (stops at train station).

Categories:

- A: Seniors novice - 5th kyu (yellow belt)
- B: Seniors 4th kyu (orange belt) - 2nd kyu (blue belt)
- C: Seniors 1st kyu & dan grades (point scoring)
- D: Veterans 30-44 years, novice - 3rd kyu (green belt)
- E: Veterans 30-44 years, 2nd kyu (blue belt) and higher (point scoring)
- F: Veterans 45+ years, novice - 3rd kyu (green belt)
- G: Veterans 45+ years, 2nd kyu (blue belt) and higher (point scoring)

Competitors are required to produce a current full BJA or affiliated licence on the day and proof of grade. No licence, no competition.

Competitors should supply their own Blue & White Belts.

Entry:

£27 per competitor (+£10 to dual enter senior & veteran category)

£5 discount if registering before 16th May.

Closing date 23rd May or when we have reached capacity if sooner.
