The first section will be a Festival of Judo for judoka aged 5-7 years. Designed to give under 8's the opportunity to learn 'rules of the game' and experience the competition side of judo. The second section is for under 15 years, Maximum grade 6th Mon.

Judoka will be pooled according to age, weight and grade, all will receive a participation medal.

Limited to 50 players the aim is to complete the first section in the morning, followed by the mini-Mon section. The timing of the Mini Mon section will be dependent on entries.
