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WEIGH IN & REGISTRATION

Players will be grouped according to weight, age and experience and not in strict weights. You will be emailed on or before 21.00 on 27th May confirming the contest time. Players not present by the given time may be fitted into any available pool or declined entry.

An Open Weigh in will take place and all players MUST weigh in wearing a plain white T-shirt and compliant judogi trousers and will receive a 0.8kg allowance. All players will wear a compliant white gi only.

THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO: All BJA / BJC / AJA licence holders.

You must produce your Association's current licence on the day confirming your grade, or proof of grade via The Dojo (for BJA players). Entrants must have graded with 6 months of 1st June unless a novice of under 6 months.

Open to Competitors aged between 8 and 15 years on the day. All contests will be run under the BJA Under 12 Rules as per the Tournament Handbook. Golden Score is one minute.

COMPETITION DETAILS: Contests: 2 minutes or 3 minutes depending on age & experience

Players will be in pools of 3,4 or 5, and matched by age, grade and weight. All players will receive medals as soon as possible after the end of their pool. Any queries or disputes on or off the mat will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision is final. The competition is run under BJA rules as per the Tournament Handbook. ALL players must have a white compliant judogi.

All entries are online only, all fields must be completed, and payment made by card.
