Groups (All ages relate to the day of competition)	Group 1: Girls & Boys aged 5-7
Participation	All competitors MUST hold a current BJA, BJC or AJA license. NO LICENSE NO ENTRY! Players must have graded within the last 12 months. Novice competitors must have held a judo membership for no longer than 6 months prior to the event.
Judogi Rules	Competitors can wear any colour judogi , as long as it's a judo suit. If you're in a BJJ gi, or any other martial-art suit, you will be turned away from the competition. ALL COMPETITORS WILL WEIGH IN IN A T-SHIRT AND GI BOTTOMS (optional for Boys to fight in white t-shirts under judogi). All female competitors will wear a plain white t-shirt under their judogi. All Judogi must fit correctly.
Randori Rules	BJA technical restrictions will apply throughout the day. Randori times shall be: Group 1 - 2minutes See BJA contest rules for details.
Competition Format	All competitors will be weighed on the day and grouped into Pools of 4 depending on age, weight, and grade . Using the index system (Age+grade+weight). It is a mixed gender event (female players competing against males will receive a fair weight advantage). All efforts will be made to find a suitable group for each competitor, the Tournament Director will consult coaches/parents if any suitable matches can't be found. If required age groups may be merged (within reason), coaches and competitors will be consulted the week of the competition date of any issues. All competitors will receive a medal .
