GIFT AID

With the British Judo Trust acting as an exempt charity, we can claim back the basic rate of tax you have paid on your donation, at no extra cost to you. This means that for every £1 you give, the Association can claim an additional 25p in Gift Aid from the Inland Revenue

TAX RELIEF FOR HIGHER RATE TAXPAYERS

Companies that donate to British Judo's Patron Club may be eligible for corporation tax relief on their charitable contributions.

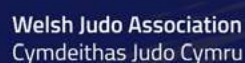
British Judo and the British Judo Trust is recognised as a governing body and charity for sport in the UK respectively, and donations made for the purpose of promoting amateur sport can qualify as allowable charitable donations under HMRC guidelines.

By contributing £5,000 annually to the Patron Club, a business may be able to deduct this amount from its total profits before tax is calculated, thereby reducing its overall corporation tax liability.

Businesses should retain records of the donation, including invoices or receipts from British Judo, and consult with their accountant or tax advisor to ensure full compliance with HMRC rules.
