VENUE:	<p>Ashlyns School Chesham Rd, Berkhamsted HP4 3AH</p> <p><u>Directions to the Dojo</u></p> <p>Follow the drive (one way system) round to the back of the school. Park opposite the sports centre, behind the school. The dojo is in the main school building (at the back), there is a Rushjudo sign next to the door.</p>
GROUPS:	<p><u>Group 1</u> – 5/ 6 & 7 Year Olds - This will start at 09.00 and we will aim to have this group completed by 11.00</p> <p><u>Group 2</u> – 8 & 9 Year Olds – This will start at 11.00 and we will aim to have this group completed by 13.00 RED BELTS ONLY</p> <p><u>Group 3</u> – 10, 11 & 12,13 year Olds – This will start at 13.00 and will aim to have this group completed by 15.00 RED AND YELLOW BELTS WILL SEEK TO KEEP SEPARATE IF POSSIBLE</p>
PARICIPATION:	<p>Players MUST hold current BJA (or affiliate) membership.</p> <p>Players MUST be aged between 5 and 13 years on the day of the event.</p>
NOTES:	<p>This will be slightly different than your standard red belt rumble, it will be focused on inexperienced players and the focus is on development rather than performance</p>
RULES:	<p>For the under 8 category Referees will not be enforcing Penalties within the randori, instead the referee will be advising the players when needed.</p> <p>For red belt and above they will get one warning then a shido if same offence is committed.</p>
JUDOGI RULES:	<p>Players MUST wear a white judogi</p> <p>Girls MUST wear a plain white t-shirt under their judogi</p>
DURATION:	<p>2 minutes, no Golden Score</p> <p>In the event of a draw, on both scores hiki-wake will be called.</p>
FORMAT:	<p>The Children will ideally be put into groups of 4, based on age, weight, and ability. There may be occasions where there is a group of 3 but we do our best to avoid this if possible. We will ask the Club coaches to provide accurate weights of the players to save time on weigh in on the day.</p> <p>All players will receive the same medal, as this is purely developmental and an opportunity to introduce your child to competitions.</p>
ENTRY FEE:	<p>£15.00 per player - Non-refundable unless tournament is cancelled.</p>
