## Eligibility:

**This is a closed event, for Surrey registered players only**

- Competitors must be over 8 years of age on the day of the competition
- Senior competitors must be aged 14 years and over on the day of the competition
- All competitors must present a valid BJA licence or a BJA affiliated association licence at the weigh-in together with proof of grade – no exceptions will be made
- Medallists may be selected for the Inter-County Teams in Woking on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2026
- No refunds will be issued after the closing date
- Gold medallists will be crowned 2026 Surrey County Champion!

## Contest Information:

- Armlocks or strangles only allowed in the Senior event
- Method of competition will be pools throughout & current BJA rules will apply
- Medals will be presented throughout the day
- Competitors must always wear suitable footwear when off the mat
- All players must wear a white judogi
- BJJ Gi's are not permitted
- Where possible, players to provide their own blue and white belts
- Only matside qualified coaches with a valid card will be allowed matside to coach
- In the event of any disputes, the decision of the Tournament Director will be final
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine categories if necessary
- Videos and photographs may be taken on the day and used on social media
- All players must weigh in with white t-shirt and judogi trousers with a 0.8kg allowance provided
- Males may compete in a white t shirt if they choose to do so. All females **MUST** wear a white t shirt.

U16 Boys:	-30, -34, -38, -42, -46, -50, -55, -60, -66, +66kgs
Senior Men 1 <sup>st</sup> Kyu & Dan:	-60,-66,-73,-81,-90,-100, +100kgs
Senior Men 2 <sup>nd</sup> & below:	-60,-66,-73,-81,-90,-100, +100kgs
Senior Ladies 1 <sup>st</sup> Kyu & Dan:	-52,-57,-63,-70,-78,+78kgs
Senior Ladies 2 <sup>nd</sup> kyu & below:	-52,-57,-63,-70,-78,+78kgs

## **INTER COUNTIES TEAM SELECTION:**

The results of the Surrey Closed will be used to help with the final team selection for the Surrey Team that will compete in the Inter Counties on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May.

For the Inter Counties, the format will be a mixed team approach – the same format as we used in last year's event.

This means that for the Senior team, we will only be selecting players for the following positions:

Senior Men: -66, -81, -100, +100kgs

Senior Ladies: -57, -70, +70kgs

It is possible for a player to complete up a weight group – for example, an -73 male could take the -81 position. The County Squad Manager will be responsible for selecting the players for both the U16 and Senior teams and will coach the teams on the day.
